

How to measure your ring size

- 1 Print this document at 100% size. Please make sure the options to fit or shrink to page are not selected in your print window.
- 2 Measure the outer box with a ruler to ensure it matches the dimensions marked.
- 3 Hold your ring against the chart and choose the letter that best matches the internal diameter of the ring. This is the size of your ring.

Please note:

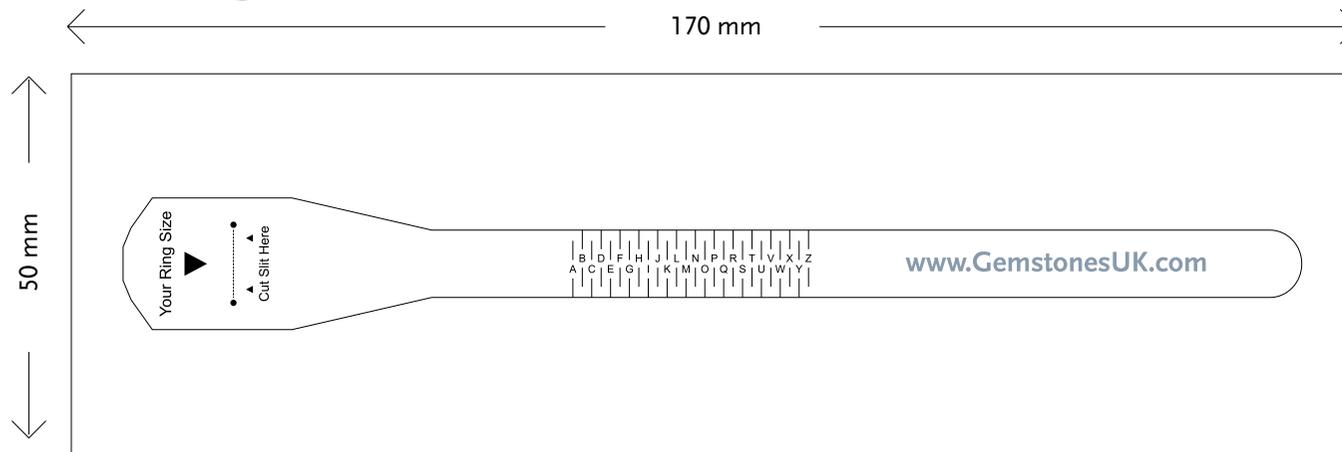
Measure with a ring similar in width to the one you are ordering. Rings with a wider band need to be a larger size, even if they will be worn on the same finger.

Be sure that both sides of your ring are the same size.

Ring Belt Sizer



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- 2 Measure the outer box with a ruler to ensure it matches the dimensions marked.
- 3 Cut out the sizer around the outline and cut a slit where indicated. Push the end through the slit to make a ring shape and slip it around your finger.
- 4 Adjust until you have a comfortable fit that slides easily over the knuckle. The letter indicated by the arrow is your ring size.

Please note:

Do not pull the sizer tightly. Make sure you are able to slide the sizer on and off your finger comfortably.

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
